The date for this year's Land and Range Contest is Wednesday Sept. 29<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Registration for the event will be held from 9:00 to 9:30 at the Webster Armory, on Sept. 29<sup>th</sup>. Please park your buses on the South side of the Webster Armory, the address of the National Guard Armory is 120 w 11<sup>th</sup> Ave. The contestants would be able to use the facilities (rest rooms) at the Armory before we dismiss to the contest sites. The contest will start about 10:00 in the field. The entry fee is \$3/ student and \$10 per school, the registration check should be made out the NE Area Land and Range. The land and range contests are usually completed by 12:00. Lunch will be provided to the Ag. Instructors and volunteers that help score the cards at the Webster School Lunchroom, 102 East 9<sup>th</sup> Ave. We warn the A&W, Mikes, Cenex and Subway about the date, for student's meals. **Remember that your school must be present to help score the cards or your team will not eligible for awards.
